Russia: Pskov region, Leningrad region, St. Petersburg

PROGRAMME BUDGET

The total Programme budget is 27.08 million EUR

European Union funding: 15.87 million EUR
Russian Federation funding: 7.94 million EUR
Republic of Latvia funding: 1 million EUR

WHO CAN APPLY

Beneficiary may be:

- Public authorities (national institutions, regional and local authorities);
- Public equivalent bodies, i.e. any legal body governed by public or private law;
- NGOs constituting legal bodies that have been established for the specific purpose of meeting needs for the general interest and not having an industrial or commercial character, and having legal personality.

ELIGIBILITY OF PROJECTS

Financing of the Programme can be assigned to projects that are:

- Implemented by at least two project partners of whom at least one from each Programme participating country;
- Implemented in the Programme area;
- Deliver a clear cross-border cooperation impact and benefits;
- Demonstrate added value to EU, national and regional strategies and programmes.
